- March 1941 Yamagata Godo Freight Truck, Inc. established
- April 1942 Fifteen companies merge, and the resulting company is named Yamagata Prefecture Daiichi Freight Trucking Co., Ltd.
- January 1951 Linehaul operations between Sendai and Tokyo begin
- September Company renamed Daiichi Freight Trucking Co., Ltd.
- September 1954 Business network extended throughout Miyagi Prefecture
- September 1959 Business network extended throughout Akita Prefecture
- November Linehaul operations between Osaka and Tokyo begin
- June 1980 Computers at all branches are brought online
- June 1984 Van operations begin
- February 1987 Business headquarters established
- March 1988 Start of comprehensive IT system operations
- May 1989 Start of second phase of online systems
- August Start of online freight system (POS [parcel online system])
- July 1990 Company renamed Daiichi Freight System, Inc.
- December 1991 Telephone and fax services begin
- November 1992 Start of Support I dispatch support system
- May 1997 Third-party logistics operations start
- May 1999 Joint deliveries of medical supplies begin
- April 2002 Aikawa Distribution Center (now relocated to Atsugi) acquires ISO 90001 certification
- August 2006 Participation in JITBOX charters begins
- April 2009 Business headquarters relocates to Shinonome in Koto-ku, Tokyo
- November 2010 Three thousand beech trees are planted at Sosei no Mori to help preserve the environment
- March 2011 Corporate colors created
- May A Chinese subsidiary, Shanghai Tri-Wall Daiichi Logistics, Co., Ltd., is established
- April 2012 Joint venture established with Tonami Holdings Co., Ltd. and Kurume Transportation Co., Ltd.
- October DT Holdings, Inc. established
- October 2013 Joint line haul services with Kurume Transportation start
- April 2014 Representative office in Hanoi, Vietnam established
- November Second-class consigned freight forwarding operations (international marine transport) begin
- Company joins Japan International Freight Forwarders Association Inc.
- July 2016 Navitrans Co., Ltd. becomes our subsidiary
